

Minister to Students Job Description

- Develop a student program focused on the students and ministry plans to grow students in their spiritual walk through:
 - Reaching lost students for Christ
 - Discipling all students to have a personal commitment to Christ
 - Planning & executing monthly fellowship for students resulting in mutual edification
 - Training students to be responsible and productive members of the body of Christ in personal evangelism, knowledge of the Word of God, and being faithful to God's direction in their personal lives.
- Communicate with parents on a monthly basis.
- Plan student ministry for each month, each upcoming quarter, and meet annually with parents to overview the upcoming year's activities. Schedule other student or parent meetings as needed.
- Understand current student culture and relate specifically with the student about the problems they face.
- Be available to counsel students, either in a group setting or privately with the student and another adult.
- Present a Godly character and personal attitude for which all church members can recognize as a positive role model.
- Encourage their family to support them and display a consistent Christian witness.
- Subscribe to the Statement of Faith for First Baptist Church of Rosenberg.
- Direct and lead the Sunday and Wednesday night ministries in cooperation with the Student ministry team, volunteers and other ministry staff.
- Engage the current 6th graders in periodic ministry opportunities by inviting and involving them to participate with the current student ministry.
- Meet and work with local student leaders when appropriate.
- Submit appropriate budgets to the Stewardship Committee annually.

General
